### Strategy, Platform, and the Connected Forest

#### Welcome and Opening Remarks

*Doug Jones – Chief of Customer Experience, Remsoft*

INFLOR CEO, Carlos Albuquerque, will join American Forest Management to demonstrate Remsoft INFLOR FMS, showing how AFM uses it to manage over 2 million acres in the USA. Attendees will see practical workflows and solution capabilities in action, from digitizing field-to-mill processes to accelerating integrated planning and execution across the supply chain.

#### Connected Forest Supply Chain (Live End-to-End Demonstration)

A live demonstration following data as it moves from long- and short-term planning through harvest scheduling, field execution, telemetry, compliance, transportation, and finally delivery at the mill. This session illustrates how integrated optimization, operations, FMS, telematics, and logistics all come together to reduce bottlenecks, improve predictability, and create a single source of truth across teams and partners.

#### Global Forestry Trends: A Cross-Regional Perspective (Fireside Chat)

A moderated fireside conversation with forestry leaders from key regions Remsoft serves, including North America, South America, Europe, and Australia. Speakers will share regional perspectives on how global forces such as climate variability, regulation, labor, and technology are shaping forestry operations today.
